

# Tulips

## **Fabric Supply List**

- **Background and border-** 6 green half-yards (ranging from light to dark)
- **Tulips and border-** 6 pink fat quarters (ranging from light to dark)
- **Stems-** 1 dark green fat quarter
- **Backing-** 3 yards
- **Binding-** ½ yard

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## Directions

Important ~ Read all directions before beginning.

All seams are a  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

It's always a good idea to check your seam allowance for accuracy before beginning a project.

## Cutting

1. From each of the green fabrics cut:

(1)  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square

(1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

(3)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

(14)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

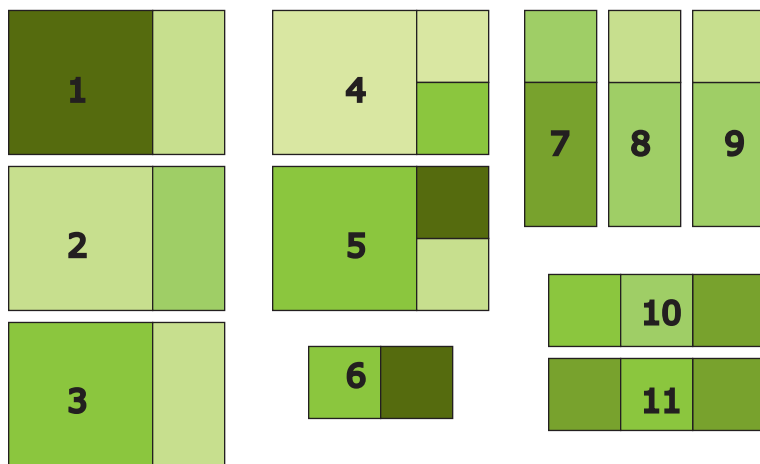
2. From each of the pink fabrics cut:

(2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square

The remainder will be used for the tulips.

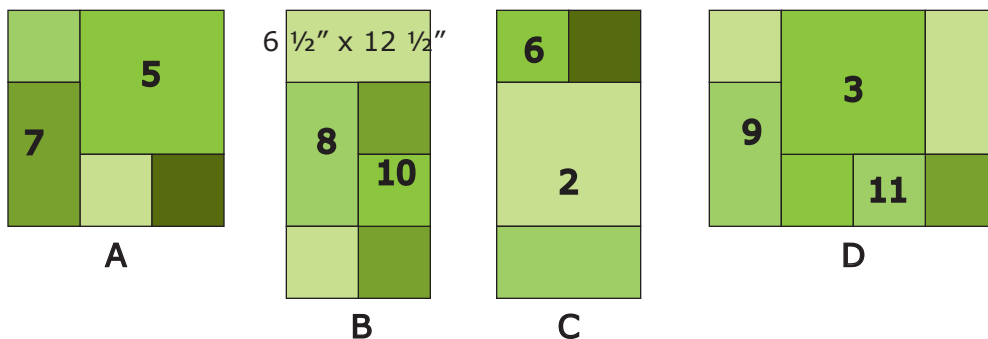
## Piecing

1. Sew together the following units. Choose your own fabric placement. They are numbered for convenience.

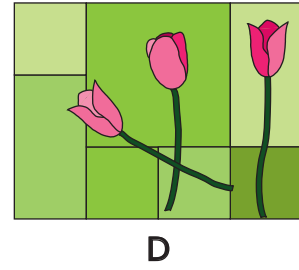
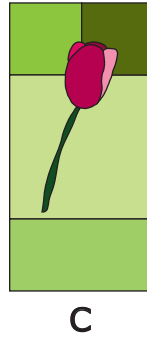
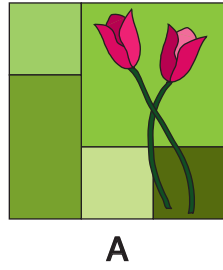
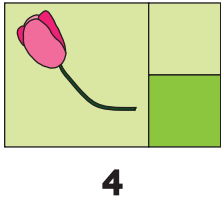


2. Sew the units together into the following sections. Sections are now labeled using letters.

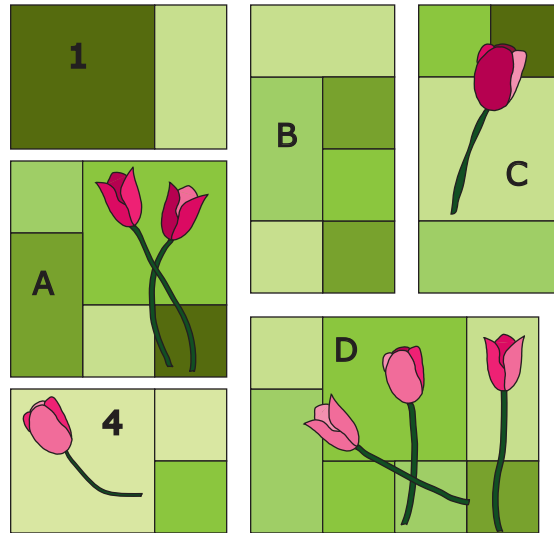
Notice that section B is made by sewing together units 8 and 10 then adding a  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top.



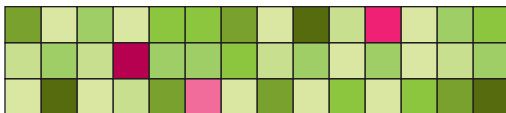
3. Applique the tulips to the following unit and sections using your favorite applique technique. For this project we used a straight stitch to color the edge. The stems are cut freehand. The tulip shapes provided on pages 5 and 6 do not include seam allowance.



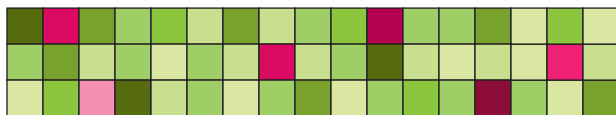
4. Lay out the units and sections as shown below. Sew together to form the background.



5. Sew together the 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares to form the side and bottom borders. The pink squares are randomly placed, feel free to add more.

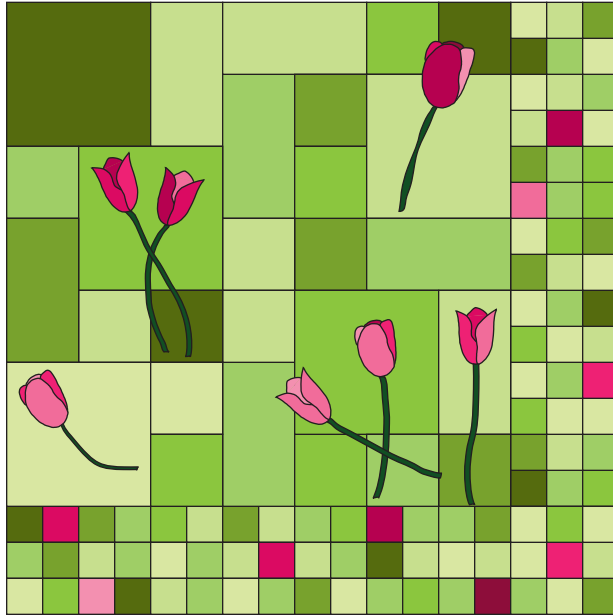


Side border, 14 squares long.



Bottom border, 17 squares long.

6. Put it all together.



7. Quilt and bind as desired.
