

Bright Sun Block

Makes one 12" finished block.



I had a great time with this vintage inspired quilt block! The sunny yellow orange fabrics remind me of a bright summer day. The kind where you have to squint your eyes and the sun looks almost like a star.

Cutting Instructions:

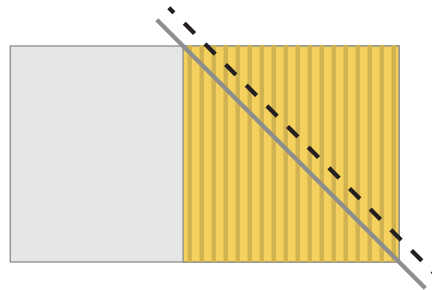
- Cut 4 – 4.5" x 4.5" background fabric
- Cut 4 – 2.5" x 4.5" background fabric
- Cut 1 – 4.5" x 4.5" Light yellow-orange (center)
- Cut 8 – 2.5" x 2.5" Light yellow-orange (star points)
- Cut 4 – 2.5" x 4.5" Dark yellow-orange

All instructions assume a 1/4" seam.

Creating flying geese:

You will need to create four 2" x 4" finished flying geese.

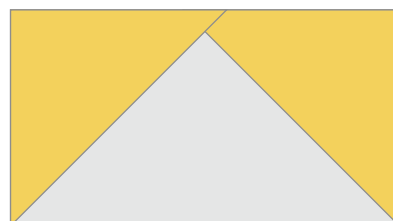
Place one background square right sides together as shown in the diagram. Draw a diagonal line as shown with a water soluble pencil onto the back of the background square and sew directly onto that line. You may want to use pins to hold these in place. Cut 1/4" away from your sewn line (dotted line in the diagram) and then press open to create one side of your triangle.



Press open to create one side of your triangle.

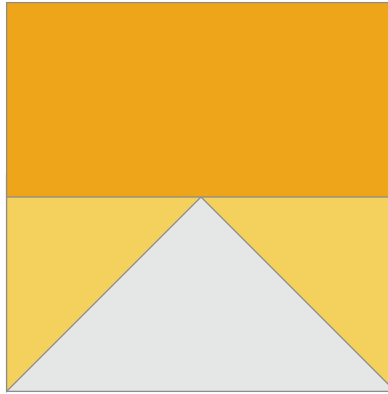


Repeat this process on the other side to create the other side of your triangle as shown in the diagram. Trim to 2.5" x 4.5" if needed.

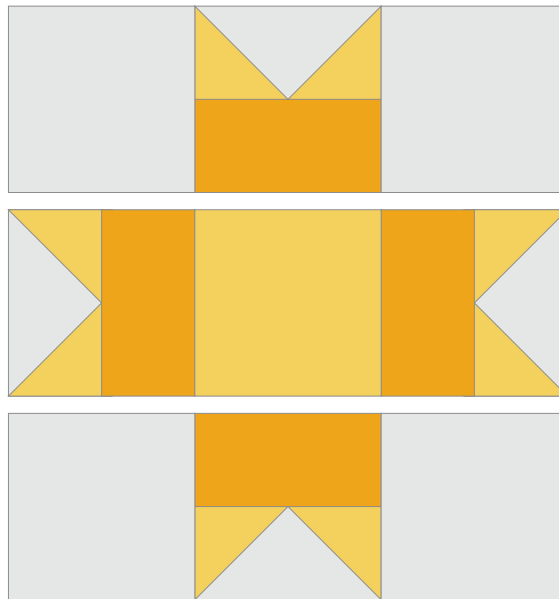


Assembling your block:

Sew each dark yellow-orange rectangle to the top of each flying geese block as shown.



Sew your nine-patch block together in rows as shown on the diagram.



Sew your rows together to finish your block!
